

MUNICIPALITY OF MARMORA AND LAKE
BYLAW NUMBER 2010-19

Being a bylaw to set water and sewer rates within
The urban areas of Marmora and Lake

WHEREAS the Municipality deems it desirable to collect revenue necessary for supplying water and sewer services to the urban areas of the Municipality of Marmora and Lake;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the corporation of the Municipality of Marmora and Lake hereby enacts as follows:

1. The monthly water and sewer rates shall be as follows:	2010 (monthly)

2. The monthly water rate covers the cost of supplying the service and delivery of one (1) cubic meter of water per day. The commercial rates cover the proportional amount of water per day. Usage above the flat rate coverage may be billed at \$1.50 per cubic meter. The flat rates apply to all properties that have the services at the curb, whether or not the properties have connections to the service, with the exception of vacant properties.
3. The combined utility deposit shall be \$150.00 for tenants as a water/sewer deposit and all new tenants may be subject to the same deposit, held interest free until the account is closed and all balances paid.
4. Any new sewer and water service connection will be completed on a time and material basis. The property owner will be required to pay a \$2000.00 deposit prior to the start of the work on the new connection.
5. The municipality will supply and install a water meter for the new service connection at no charge to the property owner.
6. That this bylaw shall take effect on the 1st day of January 2010.
