Marmora and Lake Community Centre Public Skating Rules

THERE IS A RISK OF INJURY ASSOCIATED WITH ICE SKATING.
Persons using this arena do so at their own risk.

- The Municipality of Marmora and Lake strongly recommends that all skaters wear protective equipment, but especially that children wear helmets, gloves/mitts, and be accompanied by an adult at all times, if under the age of 8 years old.
- Chairs, sleds, strollers, pylons and other obstructions are not permitted on the ice surface during public skating sessions.
- All participants must wear skates while on the ice surface.
- Food and drink are not permitted on the ice surface.
- Hockey and Figure Skating manoeuvres are not permitted during public skating sessions.
- Games such as tag or racing or power skating or crack the whip will not be permitted during public skating sessions.
- Inappropriate language or behaviour will not be tolerated at any time in the Community Centre.
- Refrain from carrying children on shoulders or in arms while skating.
- Refrain from throwing snow or ice.
- Wheel chairs are permitted. Person controlling the wheelchair must wear skates. Please keep wheelchair along the boards.
- Please skate at a sensible speed and in the direction chosen by staff supervisor.
- NO skating backwards
- Adhere to directions of Municipal staff members.
- Leave ice surface immediately when skating session is over.
- Report all incidents/accidents, injuries, misconduct or hazardous conditions to the Municipal staff on duty promptly.
- Please be courteous and respect other people's property. Please note that the Municipality of Marmora and Lake will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse to the Facility, staff or patrons.
- Skate aids are neither available nor permitted during public skating sessions.
- The Municipality of Marmora and Lake are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
